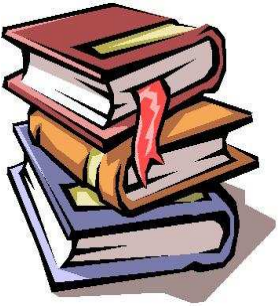
## Why support the PTSA?
